

NNHF Code of Conduct

1. We aim to alleviate human suffering related to haemophilia and related bleeding disorders, as well as its complications.
2. Our support is given regardless of the race, gender or creed of the recipients in the developing world and upon assessment of needs and capabilities to meet these needs.
3. We facilitate implementation of the UN Sustainable Development Goals by striving to reduce vulnerability of people served through our grants - addressing basic health needs, and fostering sustainable solutions.
4. Our support will not be used to further particular economic, political or religious purposes.
5. We endeavour to respect the cultures, social structures and values of the communities and countries we work in.
6. We will strengthen local capabilities and co-operate with governments, private institutions and voluntary associations.
7. Our support will never be imposed upon beneficiaries. We endeavour to find ways to create true partnerships and involve beneficiaries in the formulation, planning and management of projects.
8. We will strive to promote sustainable solutions in line with basic needs.
9. We will be accountable both to those we seek to assist and to those from whom we accept resources.
10. We will be open and transparent, reporting on the impact of our work and the factors limiting or enhancing that impact.
11. We adopt and require our partners to adopt a zero tolerance policy to corruption and bribery.
12. In all our activities and communications, we will recognise and respect people with haemophilia and related bleeding disorders as dignified humans.
