

NNHF Fellowship - Guidelines

Purpose

NNHF offers 4 Fellowships per year, each to the value of Swiss Francs (CHF) 25,000, for **specialised healthcare professional training** for a duration of 4 to 6 months. This is for further education of physicians, nurses, laboratory technicians or other members of a multidisciplinary team from developing and emerging countries. The trainings take place in internationally recognised centres of choice which have specialty knowledge in the respective field and are able to provide training.

The main purpose is the transfer and spread of haemophilia & allied bleeding disorders expertise to the developing world.

Decision criteria

The applicant for the Fellowship should prove to have a great interest and/or some experience in haemophilia & allied bleeding disorders care. Furthermore, the applicant should state which needs the training shall fulfil in his/her country and what purpose it will serve in his/her centre upon return.

The training schedule needs to match with the objectives and be planned in a corresponding timeframe.

The decision will be announced in written to the applicant by NNHF Management.

Application

The application has to contain the following:

- Completed application form
- Applicant's Curriculum Vitae
- Confirmation letter of the hosting institute approving the starting date, duration and content of the Fellowship as well as approving to take over the support of the organisation of the Fellowship, additional course fees and material needs (if applicable)
- Training schedule for the fellowship
