

NNHF Community Award - Guidelines

Purpose

NNHF offers an annual award to the value of Swiss Francs (CHF) 16,000 for an outstanding activity contributing to the benefit of the haemophilia & allied bleeding disorders community in the developing world.

Realised with high personal engagement, the improvement should be demonstrated with achievements in the areas such as capacity building, infrastructure improvement, awareness creation, social activity, or fundraising and have a long term impact on the haemophilia & allied bleeding disorders community in developing and transition countries.

Eligibility

Any private or professional person who has realised the activity on a voluntary basis.

In addition, a proposition for the use of the CHF 16,000 to the benefit of the haemophilia & allied bleeding disorders community should be contained in the application.

Nomination

The award candidate must be nominated to NNHF by a third party and cannot apply him/herself.
